Trail Update & Groomer Status

Groomers:

Trails:

We have a number of re-routes and improvements to our trail system that we are trying to complete by the start of the season. These may include clearing brush, installing a culvert, or helping with a bridge repair or install . Most recently, we started with the replacement of a bridge at the entrance to Staubs woods last Sunday. The Bridge is out and the culvert is in . We are planning another work detail this Saturday 08/31 to continue widening the entrance to the woods - small overhanging branches and saplings to clear. We will also be continuing to cover the culvert with dirt and stone, mostly tractor loader work .

Trails continued....

Did anyone else see the news this week? **“Farmers’ almanac predicts colder than normal winter for most US”**. We can only hope this means a snowier winter for our region.

As Dan noted above, we have a number of trail repairs and improvements needed before the snow starts to fall. I will be focusing on the North Trail System along with our Trail Bosses to address these repairs. Here are just a few of the projects in front of us:

- Install culvert on Burch property just north of Curtis Road
- Repair or replace gate post on railroad bed between Wiler and Sweden Walker Roads
- Tree trimming and brush hogging between Sweden Walker & Lawrence Road along with general trimming in all wooded areas
- Repair concrete culvert west of TRS Pools

Last year's early snowfall caught us by surprise with several trails not yet installed. When this happens, we end up short on resources, people and equipment, as all of our Trail Bosses are attempting to install trails at the same time. We would like to combat the situation this year by installing trail in October and November where possible. Obviously, hunting season and late crops will prevent some trails from being installed until late December. With that, I ask our club members, Trail Bosses, and Landowners to be thinking about trail sections that can be installed early. In your travels, if you notice a field that has not been planted this year, or a corn field that has been harvested early, please feed back this information to me. We will work with Landowners to coordinate early trail installations where ever possible.

Hilton Sno-Flyers Text Alert System

The HSF text alert system that debuted earlier last year will be active again this season. It is being used to get important club information out to people quickly that may not have access to the internet at all times. Text alerts will be sent out mainly by Steve Frosini (Webmaster) with the approval of The Board of Directors. Other board members will also have the ability to send out alerts. Text alerts will consist of Trail information (opening – closing), hazardous conditions, in-season re-routes, emergency work details, club meetings, club events and major work details. The system is secure and your phone number will never be sold or shared. You will also never be spammed. We will do our best to keep the alerts to a minimum and you can always cancel the service by replying STOP. Hopefully this system will spread to members that don't come to meetings or visit the website much so they can keep informed about important club news.
