After 13 months and countless hours spent working with landowners, the Town of Ogden, and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, Jim Meyer (and others) have gained approval for the Whittier Road trail crossing. This is an example of how much time and effort it takes to make a trail system, and how much it takes for rerouting a trail. Please respect the landowners and their neighbors by staying on the marked trails and slowing down near homes to keep the noise down.

The Club will be selling Raffle Tickets to benefit the NYSSA again this year. The club will get to keep \$2.50 from each \$5.00 ticket sold. Many clubs in Western New York, including the Hilton Sno-Flyers are marking the trails in open fields with a single stake in the center of the trail. This is referred to as a "Divided Trail" and you are to ride to the right of the Orange "Blaze" Trail Sign.



Hazard marker signs are used to mark hazards near the trail such as openings in hedgerows and culverts. (Hazard markers are used along roadways in the same manner.) Some clubs are using the hazard markers to divide the trail. The Diagonal lines point down to the trail.
